WHEREAS, said budget has been heretofore regularly adopted by the Commissioner's Court of Morris County, and

WHEREAS, all other things required by law to be done have been done properly by the appropriate officials, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by affirmative vote of the Commissioner's Court of Morris County, Texas at a regular meeting held in the Commissioner's Courtroom of the County of Morris the 8TH day of September 2020.

THIS RATE WILL RAISE MORE REVENUE FROM PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BY AN AMOUNT OF \$6,052, WHICH IS A 0.00 PERCENT INCREASE FROM LAST YEAR'S BUDGET. THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE TO BE RAISED FROM NEW PROPERTY ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL THIS YEAR IS \$23,900.00.
